## MINI GRANTS

Awarded **\$396,092** for programming at **33 schools** to educate and encourage students to walk, bike and roll to school safely



## WALK/BIKE AND ROLL TO SCHOOL DAYS

**208** schools participated in Walk and Roll to School Day (October)

**195** schools participated in Bike and Roll to School Day (May)

Michigan ranked **tenth** in WR2SD and **twelfth** in BR2SD in the nation

National rankings are based on data from the National Center for Safe Routes to School. They are factored by the number of schools per state but do not include high schools. The participating counts for MI include high schools, but the national rankings do not.

## MAJOR GRANTS

Awarded **\$2,555,283** to **12 schools** across four communities for programming and improvements to sidewalks, pathways, signals and signage


