Awarded **\$396,092** for programming at 33 schools to educate and encourage students to walk and bike to school safely

**208** schools participated in Walk and Roll to School Day (October)

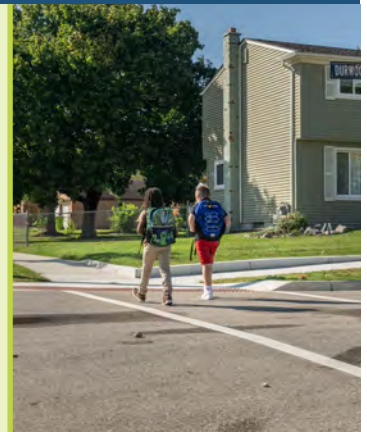
**195** schools participated in Bike and Roll to School Day (May)
